Colour: Golden with brilliant clarity.

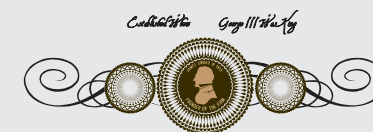
Nose: Clean, crisp aroma, hints of vanilla.
