This Cask Islay 10 Year Old Special Edition follows on from our renowned 1st release of Cask Islay Sherry Edition in 2019 - this time with an age statement, and an amplified sherry character.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: Deep amber.

Nose: Blood orange, blackberry and rich coastal smoke.

Palate: Dark cherry, tangy marmalade and caramelised nut praline.

Finish: Long and warming, with spiced bramble jam over gentle ash.

Coastal smoke, orange, raisin praline

Matured in Sherry. Non-chill filtered. Natural colour.

OUR CASK STORY

This 2026 release is a vatting of:

5 1st fill Oloroso sherry butts from 2015.

Initially matured in rejuvenated refill (dechar/rechar) sherry butts for 9½ years then finished in 1st fill Oloroso sherry butts for 18 months.

13 1st fill Oloroso sherry barriques from 2016.

Fully maturation in Oloroso sherry-seasoned ex-wine barriques from Bodegas Hidalgo - La Gitana which were selected in person by A. D. Rattray during a visit to Jerez in 2010.

"The casks have been seasoned with Oloroso Faraon for around 2 years. During this period they have been at our vineyards, El Cuadrado. This vineyard has been owned by us for over 150 years (like Dewar Rattray!). It is one of the top 3 vineyards in the Sherry area. It is located in the historic district Balbaina Alta, and it is the highest point on the Sherry Area. This is one of the reasons by which our wines are slightly salty and very fine. These casks were originally owned by CVNE from Rioja."
